


Occasionally you might be required to reactivate your Opera 3 generally you will be notified when logging into Opera 3 with a time scale to obtain the required activation.

To obtain your relevant key please send Profile Support support@profile.co.uk the "Release Number" shown when logging in.



We will then email you the required key, as below:


To activate you need to do the following:

- 1. Log everyone out of Opera 3.
- 2. Browse to the Opera 3 System folder on the server.

 Default location would be \\~Your~Server\O3 Server VFP Static and Dynamic\System
- 3. Rename the Opera.sys to Opera.OLD-28-02-2025 for example. If you can't see it, you need to do the following:

Windows 11

Select View > Show > File name extensions & Hidden items.



Older Windows Operating systems.

Select View > Options > Change folder and search options.

Select the View tab and, in Advanced settings, select Show hidden files, folders, and drives.


Untick Hide extensions for known types.

Untick Hide protected operating system files and OK.





- 4. Open Opera 3.
- 5. Enter in the details above exactly as shown on the activation card emailed to you.






Profile bespoke activation

If you receive a message logging into Opera 3 that your bespoke activation is invalid or expiring.

You will need to contact support with the PMTB number and Opera 3 version you are running.

To obtain your relevant key please send Profile Support support@profile.co.uk the "Release Number" shown when logging in and the PMTB number highlighted or similar shown in the examples here:





You will then receive an email with your new key to be applied following the instructions below: Please find below new licence activation and installation instructions.

The process only needs to be carried out on one machine and other users can be in the system.

NOTE:

Don't hold the activation screen open too long as it can prevent users from logging on if they've logged out.

NOTE:

If the licence has already expired then you will need to log in as the **ADMIN** user.



1. If you have the Ribbon Bar menu activated, and the following option is available, then click on this and go straight to option 5.



- 2. If the Ribbon Bar is active, but the above option is not available, then follow the notes 3 and 4 below.
- 3. Please access the **Help** drop-down menu from within the Opera3 system. This may involve temporarily turning the **Ribbon** menu off in user **Preferences** and logging back on.
- 4. Select: **Bespoke Activations**.
- 5. Select the correct **PMTB** code from the list and go to the **General** tab.





- 6. Copy and paste the **Activation Key** (above) into the field making sure the paste doesn't chop off the last character.
- 7. Select **Test** activation, if successful, then,
- 8. Create Licence file.
